On Thursday 18th April KS1 and Reception went on a school trip to watch Bluey's Big Show at the Forum in Bath. As per the KS2 trip earlier this year the PTA made a significant contribution towards the cost of the trip on behalf of each child.

Experiencing theatre first hand will stick in the children's memories for a lifetime. We heard that there was lots of giggles and laughter and the school is now full of bluey fans!





The PTA's big runding project currently is the Outdoor Play and Learning (OPAL) project. The purpose of OPAL is to ensure that every school child has an amazing play time everyday.

As part of our commitment to OPAL, we have agreed to fund a pond cover which will enable the pond area to be more freely used and for the children to take part in pond dipping.

In the meantime the drier weather means that the children are getting more use of the forest school area which was recently revamped by the PTA. We also know that being in the UK means lots of rain so we have purchased two Welly sheds so that each child will be able to store a pair of wellies at school and access outdoor play whatever the weather.

Our next focus is on installing a giant sandpit for the children to play in. If anyone has any contacts that may enable us to purchase sand at a reduced rate please do let us know. Once we have sourced all the materials we plan to hold another volunteer day to get it built so watch this space
