Exciting new Outdoor Play and Learning (OPAL) programme is in the pipeline!

The PTA are thrilled to announce we are funding a programme to improve children's play and learning at school.

OPAL is a mentor-supported school improvement programme addressing all 18 areas a school must plan for if they want to sustainably improve the quality of play. The OPAL Primary Programme is the only one of its kind, blending elements of strategic school improvement practice, action planning, self-evaluation, playwork skills and knowledge and twenty years of action-research.

School staff will be receiving their first training session on January 29th.

As part of the programme implementation we will also be looking at funding for new play equipment and imaginative play donations.

"Research shows that children's mental and physical health is getting worse and that great play can make it better. During seven years at primary school, children spend 1.4 years at play.


