Progress update!

As an introduction to OPAL a member of the PTA committee was able to attend a session at the school to hear more about OPAL and how it will benefit our children.

Children spend seven years at primary school from reception to year six. Over this time they will spend on average 20% of this time at play. We want to develop this and ensure children are given the opportunity to learn those vital play skills which will help them to learn risk, have fun, challenge themselves and enjoy high quality play.

Do you remember your play times? Climbing trees, Building dens, using your imagination?

By adopting this approach to play times the aim is to:

Improve wellbeing
Develop self regulation
Increase physical activity
Aid social & emotional development
Learn to manage risk
and have FUN!


