As a family we understand that there are many types of computer, including tablets, games consoles and phones.



We will use our computers and the internet safely and sensibly as part of a range of leisure activities.


When I use any computer, I will be SMART:

ACCEPTING - I will only accept and open messages from people I know and trust.



RELIABLE - I know that some people online do not tell the truth and pretend to be friends when they are not - I will check what is true with a trusted adult.



TELL - I will tell a trusted adult if I see something I do not think is right online or if someone is unkind or worries me.

I will ask an adult if I want to use the computer.

I will take care of the computer and other equipment.

I will ask for help from a trusted adult if I am not sure what to do or if I think I have done something wrong.

I will tell a trusted adult if I see something that upsets me on the screen.

If I need to make a username or password I will let a trusted adult know.

If I have a username or password I will keep it safely within my family or my teacher.

I will check with a trusted adult if I am on the internet and want to go on a different site.

I will tell a trusted adult if I think that one of my friends is not keeping the SMART Rules with the technology that we use.

I will be polite, kind and considerate online.

I know that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use the computers.
